It is wonderful to see our attendance improving. Our attendance data shows we are above state and network average, both in attendance rates (90.6%) and students attending >=90% of the time (63.2%). Let's keep this focus as we move into the second half of the term.

Our preliminary NAPLAN results have been released and I am very pleased to report that we are seeing some strong improvement in literacy and numeracy. Of note is improved results in spelling, numeracy and reading. Individual student reports will be issued shortly. The results are indicative of the strong focus on quality teaching and assessment practices and commitment to ongoing improvements of student achievement.

You might have seen some posters around town featuring Coramba students and teachers to promote the upcoming Coffs Harbour Running festival. This event is on **Sunday, 11th September 2022** and we can enter the schools challenge with a chance to win prize money in the small schools division. # **Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL)**

This year, staff are undertaking Professional Development in the 'Berry Street Education Model' which enables teachers to increase engagement of students and improve all student's self-regulation, relationships, wellbeing, growth and academic achievement. This term, students are learning different strategies for being present, centred and ready to learn. During the first 4 weeks of term, students have learned strategies to self-regulate by finding their centre, practiced deep breathing and different techniques for mindfulness. Students are highly engaged in their learning and are showing great improvements in self-regulation.
