As we start the new year here are a few important reminders regarding routines, processes upcoming events:


Drop-off/pick-up

Please ensure you are using the Keevers Close drop off area – not Short Street. This is a staff carpark and not suitable for student drop-offs or pick-ups due to limited space and safety reasons. There is no footpath for student use or a clear line of sight for drivers to see if students are in the carpark. In the afternoon, parents are most welcome to come into school grounds, however, please wait in the undercover area, as students can get distracted if they see their parents, and teachers need to ensure end of day procedures in the classroom are smooth and organised.

Absences

Every day counts and this year we will continue our focus on improving our attendance. Please ensure you child is at school every day and if they are absent, please advise the office either by phone call, SMS on the school mobile or by email. All absences need to be explained and it is department policy that we follow up on unexplained absences either that day or by the following day.

Meeting with teachers

We value our relationships with our parents/carers very highly and strongly believe that you are partners in your child's education. If you feel you need to speak with your child's teacher, please phone the office to make a suitable time. Be mindful that teachers are on duty or doing preparation in the morning, so this is not a good time to 'catch' them. Teachers are available most afternoons and can give you the time you might need, providing they have notice.

Welcome Circle

We hold a Welcome Circle every morning at 8:50am. This is a wonderful routine that we have been doing for some time now. It sets up students for the day with a positive mindset and allows for students and teachers to connect in a supportive, inclusive way. Please ensure your child is here at this time. We are aware that one of our buses can arrive a little late. These students can simply join in when they arrive.

Student Digital Sign in

We have moved from a paper-based student sign into a digital sign in. This is one of our attendance strategies so students can self-monitor their attendance and work towards rewards for consistent attendance. Students can go to the library as soon as they arrive to check in. If they are late, they can always sign in at lunchtime.

Latecomers/early leavers

If your child is late to school or is leaving early, they **must** be signed out at the office. Students are not permitted to arrive late or leave early without a slip signed by the parent and a staff member. This is for safety reasons and is a Department of Education Policy.
